



ERISA Surpasses Expectations with Jefferson Health

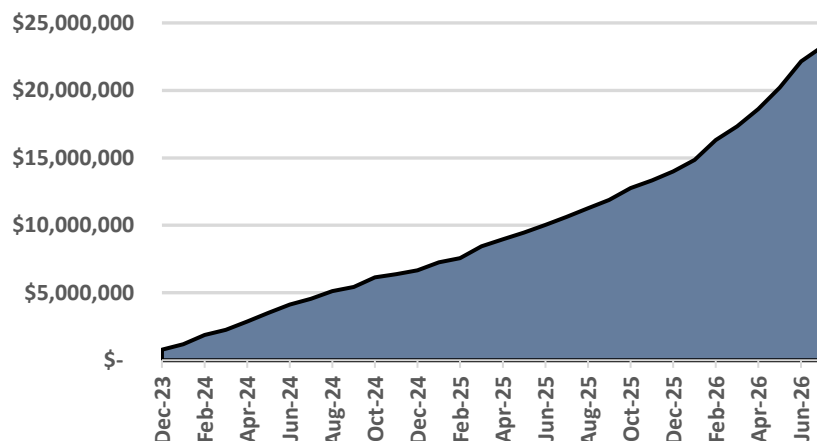
Overtaking Denials Quickly

ERISA Recovery partnered with Jefferson Health in late 2023. The immediate goal was to find significant revenue from denied and aged claims in a short period of time. Reports began coming in during late November 2023 and after only **2 full months** of working together, ERISA was able to find and appeal over **\$1.2 million** in winnings for Jefferson.

After seeing the immediate impact, Jefferson increased the relationship by sharing more data and reports with ERISA. The result after **2.5 years is over \$23 million in recoveries with over \$10 million in the pipeline.**

In May 2024, Jefferson Health and Lehigh Valley Health Network announced a merger that would place them in the top 15 not-for-profit health systems in the US. Upon closing, the integrated system will operate 30 hospitals and more than 700 sites of care. ERISA looks forward to growing its relationship with the expanded network by continuing to uncover lost revenue from denied and aged claims.
